I further confirm that the submitted artwork complies fully with the following requirements for originality and date of completion:

- (1) the artwork is my original creation completed within the last two years and is not, in whole or in part, a copy of any other person's work or photograph, and
- (2) the artwork was created solely by me and not under supervision of an instructor.

This Entry Form also constitutes my approval for the use of a reproduction of my artwork in Piccolo Spoleto Juried Art Exhibition invitations, posters and programs.

Please confirm that the images on your CD appear *in the same order* as the Images listed to the right on the Entry Form. If the order differs, attach a list to the CD holder to explain which CD image goes with which image number on the Entry Form.

If your work is not for sale, write "NFS" for the price on the Entry Form. The Entry Form information will be used in the Exhibition Program and on artwork labels. ***Please be sure that all information is accurate and legible!***

Verify that your entry package includes your CD, a \$25 check payable to **Charleston Artist Guild** and a self-addressed, stamped # 10 business envelope. Send it to **Charleston Artist Guild, PO Box 21086, Charleston, SC 29413-1086**. Do not send entries to the Office of Cultural Affairs.

Call for Entries

Who May Apply. The 26th Annual Piccolo Spoleto Juried Art Exhibition is open to all South Carolina artists. Two dimensional artwork ("Painting/2D") and photography will be accepted.

About Piccolo Spoleto. Celebrating its 32nd year, Piccolo Spoleto is the official outreach arm of Spoleto Festival USA, the world's most comprehensive and finest arts festival.

Exhibition Jurors:

Painting/2d: Margaret Hoybach. Margaret is a multi-talented artist, author and teacher who specializes in watercolors. A native of Washington, DC, Margaret lives near Charleston, received her BA degree from the University of Maryland School of Fine Arts and also did advanced studies at the University of California at Davis. A significant portion of her professional career has been dedicated to conducting art workshops and seminars around the United States and Europe. She lectures to art guilds, professional organizations, colleges, universities, and museums.

Photography: Jack Alterman. Jack has been photographing professionally for more than 30 years and opened Alterman Studios in 1980 in Charleston. He received his technical training at the Brooks Institute of Photography in Santa Barbara, California. His expertise includes aerial, industrial, catalogue and environmental photography as well as studio portraiture, travel essays and award-winning wildlife photography.

Exhibition Sponsors and Coordinator. The 2010 Exhibition is sponsored by the City of Charleston Office of Cultural Affairs and coordinated by the Charleston Artist Guild. The Festival title sponsors are Publix and Publix Supermarkets Charities.

For hand delivery of entry packages, the Charleston Artist Guild Gallery is located in downtown Charleston at 160 East Bay Street, Charleston, SC 29401. The Gallery is open Monday through Saturday from 11 am to 6 pm and from 1 to 5 pm on Sunday.

May 10. Date for notification of selected artists. Delivery instructions for accepted artwork will be included.

May 25. Deliver selected works to the Charleston Visitor Center at 375 Meeting Street from **Noon to 3:00 pm**.

May 28 - June 11. Exhibition is open 8:30 am to 5:00 pm daily at the Charleston Visitor Center.

June 6, 5:00 - 7:00 pm. Awards Ceremony and Artists Reception at the Charleston Visitor Center. Open to the public.

June 12, Saturday, 9:00 am to Noon. Artists pick up all work. *The City of Charleston, The Charleston Visitor Center and Charleston Artist Guild will not be responsible for work not picked up.*

Entry Specifications & Eligible Work:

All submitted works must have been produced within the last two years and not previously exhibited at the Piccolo Spoleto or MOJA Arts Festivals or the City Gallery at Waterfront Park. Craftwork and jewelry are not eligible for entry.

Painting/2D: Two dimensional fine artwork in all media are eligible for entry. Fiber art, collage and other media in addition to traditional oil, watercolor and pastel are acceptable. Artwork must be original and not copies of the work of others. Colored or otherwise altered photographs must be submitted in the Photography category.

Photography: all types of photography - from straight prints to digitally or manually altered images - are acceptable.

Entry Fee. \$25 non-refundable entry fee. Please make check payable to "Charleston Artist Guild."

Size Limitations and Display Requirements.

Artwork will be mounted on 42" wide display screens. One wall of the Visitor Center can accommodate larger pieces. Artwork wider than 42" or taller than 5' will only be accepted to the extent that wall display space is available.

All artwork must be framed and ready for hanging with screw eyes and wire. Finished edge wrap is acceptable as long as screw eyes and wire are attached.

Weight may not exceed 25 pounds.

Duration of Display and Sales of Art.

Accepted work may not be removed from the Exhibition before June 12. An Exhibition Program listing participating artists, their phone numbers and the title and price of their work will be available during the Exhibition. Artwork sales shall be the responsibility of each artist.

Insurance. The City of Charleston provides damage and theft insurance for artwork on display at the Charleston Visitor Center. Insurance coverage is limited to the fair market value of a work.

Jurying from Digital Images. All jurying will be done from digital images submitted on a CD in a .jpg or .jpeg format readable by a Microsoft Windows equipped computer. ***Poor quality images have been a frequent cause for rejection of work in previous years. Please submit clear, well-lit and properly cropped images!***

Number of Images and Labeling of Images. Submit up to three artworks with one digital image for each entry. If the order of your images on the CD differs from the order of the titles you have listed on the Entry Form, securely attach a list to the CD holder that explains which CD image corresponds to each title listed on your Entry Form.

Neither your name nor the artwork title should be superimposed on the digital images. (A normal artist's signature appearing on a Painting/2D work is fine, but don't add names or titles to the digital image of the work).

CDs will not be returned unless specifically requested and a self-addressed return package with adequate pre-paid postage is provided.
